#### December 2014 A.D. - THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Here it comes again! Thanksgiving and that "way too full feeling" are just behind us. Advent, Christmas, and the New Year are just around the corner. The thought of holiday preparation, gifts, cards, parties, and hectic days, is enough to make a person get anxious.

Where has the time in 2014 gone? This year seems to be whizzing by rapidly, then a few weeks ago I was reading about the year 1752. 
