Thoughts From The Pastor - April / May 2016 A.D.

Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

During the month of April and the first half of May, we are in the Easter season of the church calendar. The resurrection of Jesus Christ from death to life is "good news of great joy" that is too wonderful to celebrate only on one Sunday! So, we in the Christian Church have chosen to zero in on Jesus' rising from the dead to cover a little more than the 40 days that Jesus showed Himself to be alive to His disciples before He ascended into heaven.

Our first readings during the Easter season are not from the Old Testament as usual. Rather, they are readings from the Acts of the Apostles. Each reading speaks about Jesus' resurrection and how that affected thousands of people -- many for their salvation as the Holy Spirit, working through the Word of God, brought them to saving faith in the crucified and risen Jesus Christ.

As people today continue to hear the good news of Jesus Christ's death and resurrection, the Holy Spirit continues to bring "those who are to be saved" to faith in Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior. By God's grace, this includes us who believe in Jesus Christ as the Savior of all people.

In the question and answer section of Luther's Small Catechism with Explanation which deals with the Lord's Prayer, we learn that the word "amen" means "so shall it be". When we use "amen" at the end of a prayer, we use it to show our hearty approval of what was in our petitions.

That's another way of thinking about the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. God the heavenly Father has whole heartily approved of what His Son, Christ the Lord, has done for the redemption of all people through Christ's perfect life, innocent suffering, and death on the cross. Easter is God's loud and victorious "Amen" to all that Jesus did!!!

To the news that "Christ is risen", may our joyful response be: "He is risen indeed. Amen!!!"

May the love of the risen Lord Jesus always be in your heart!
